This project is an opportunity for disabled people to be paid to make art.



Disability Arts in Surrey wants to give funding to people for their arts projects. We also call this 'commissions'.



Funding is money that is given to people and organisations for projects. The money must be used in a certain way.

The project would give you a budget of £1000 to make new art. The project would also give you advice about making your art and help you to share your work with new people.



Ideas for projects can include theatre, performance, art, dance, film, photography, music, poetry and more!
