# **AN ARTIST RESIDENCY AT A GALLERY AND FUNDING**

### **About DAISY**



DAISY is an organisation which celebrates deaf, disabled and neurodiverse artists in Surrey.



This is an easy read summary to tell you about our residency and how you can apply to take part.

This project is an opportunity for disabled people to be paid

to make art and to create artwork inside a gallery in the summer: **15th August - 16th September 2023**



An artist residency is a period of time in a certain space to create your art. This place will be the New Ashgate Gallery in Farnham.



DAISY wants to give funding to people for their arts projects and to give them a space in a gallery to work from.

Funding is money that is given to people and organisations for projects. The money must be used in a certain way.

**£1000**

The project would give you a budget of £1000 to make new art. The project would also give you advice about making your art and help you to share your work with new people.



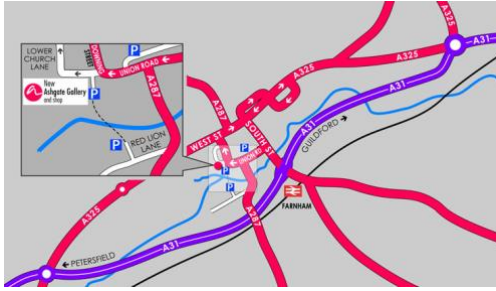
Ideas for projects can include theatre, performance, art, dance, film, photography, music, poetry and more!

With these commissions we are working with New Ashgate Gallery to offer disabled artists this opportunity.



New Ashgate Gallery will be the location for the residency. It is in Farnham in Surrey.



They may ask you to do certain other things as part of the residency.



There may be visitors to the gallery that would like to speak to you about your work.

## Who is the residency for?

- deaf, disabled and neurodiverse people
- artists

- people who live or work in Surrey
- people who create art like painting, drawing, creative, writing, crafts or performance.

## **What the funding is for**

The funding is for creative projects. We will choose which artist does the residency and receives the funding.

## **What we are looking for**

Artists working in any artform - but nothing too messy! The work can be linked to any subject or theme who are keen for some support to progress their artistic development.

We would like an artist that is confident to talk to gallery visitors about their work and we are especially interested in anyone that would like to create work with the public.

## **How to apply**

You can only apply once. You need to fill in an application form. This is on the website:

There is space in the application form for you to tell us everything you need to know about what you would like to do during the residency.
